

## 2021 Summary of Constitutional Revisions

A church's constitution is a fluid document that should reflect the membership. Your elected Consistory members have approved the following modifications to the Constitution of Richville United Church of Christ

In summary:

<b>Area of Change:</b>		
Article VI – Governing Body - Quorum	A quorum shall consist of 15% of the active members	A quorum shall consist of a minimum of 10% of active members. Should total active membership at the time of a congregational meeting of the church ever include fewer than 50 members, then a quorum shall consist of a majority of active members in attendance at the time of the congregation meeting.
Article VII – Consistory	Nominating Committee shall consist of 6 members not including the Pastor	Nominating Committee shall consist of 3 members not including the Pastor
